PHYSICAL THREAT ASSESSMENTS

Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) begins with the environment itself by using lighting, sightlines, boundaries, and layout to make safe behavior feel natural and harmful behavior difficult. Physical security builds on that foundation by adding the systems and tools that detect, delay, and respond when prevention is not enough.

Simply stated, CPTED influences behavior through thoughtful design while physical security reinforces protection through equipment, procedures, and readiness.

Together these approaches create a balanced safety posture for organizational protection of personnel and property.
