*The same concepts translate directly to **MILITARY INSTALLATIONS**, where Fire/EMS, Security Forces, law enforcement, and Emergency Operations Centers all play a role in the response to an active threat or mass-casualty incident.*

TACTICAL EMERGENCY CASUALTY CARE (TECC)

- TECC is a set of guidelines used for trauma care in high-threat environments.
- Learn the principles and practice the skills to address life-threatening injuries.
- Designed for first responders who may be first on scene.
- Learn best practices for assessing and treating traumatic injuries.
- Integrate and coordinate care within an RTF team.

RTF OPERATIONS

- RTF unifies Fire/EMS, law enforcement, and military
- Define and execute the roles
- Operational command and control.
- Team movement and casualty extraction.
- Communications and interoperability.
- Integration of Fire/EMS, LEO Security Forces and (EOC) into a coordinated response.
- Scenario-based, stress-inoculation training.
